1. Areas available for clinical experience are indicated on the sign up sheet below.
2. Please have student meet in the hospital main lobby.
3. From there, students will be greeted by Sandy Schmitt, Nurse Development Specialist, and escorted to the Nurse Recruiting Conference Room.
4. Please page Sandy Schmitt at (313) 503-5048 if any student cancels prior to the event.
5. Please refer to the “plan for the day” indicated below.
6. Students will be OBSERVING only.
7. Students should be sure to eat breakfast! Breakfast will not be provided by the hospital!
8. **Students should dress appropriately. This includes *clean casual dress*. No jeans, belly shirts, tennis shoes, open-toe shoes, mini skirts, spike high heels, facial piercings etc.**
9. PLEASE instruct your students **NOT** to bring purses or valuables with them. We have a place to store their coats, but no locked area for purses. Oakwood is not responsible for any stolen items.
10. A pizza lunch will be provided free of charge by Oakwood Hospital. **(Please notify Sandy Schmitt of any student food restrictions.)**
